The candidate will demonstrate competence in one or more European languages, other than English if this is the medium of instruction at school, at a level approximately equivalent to A1 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

2 Knowledge about Europe

The candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the importance of the relationship between India and one or more European countries.

3 Residence Abroad

For those who are able to travel to Europe: a reflective report on the visit of approximately ten pages.

For those who are unable to travel to Europe: evidence of considerable collaborative work with a partner school or a pen pal in Europe.

UCAPE offers teachers and management the opportunity to meet their colleagues and to network each year in Europe at the annual conference. An annual meeting in Jaipur is envisaged.

UCAPE communicates with its member schools regularly through the Bulletin Ucape Scolaires (BUS) in French, and by e-mail. Events and initiatives are showcased on the Association's website (www.ucape.eu).

UCAPE assists with providing paperwork for visas for participants in our approved projects in Europe.
